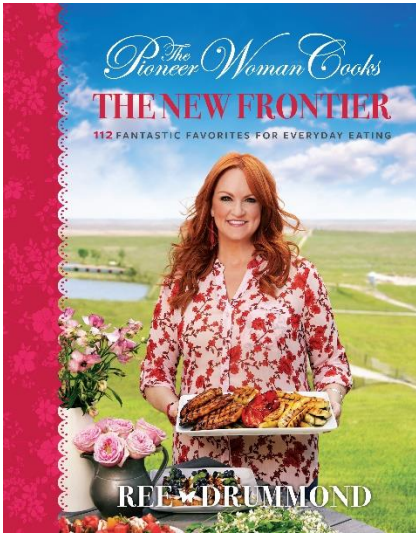

OFFICIAL EVENT GUIDELINES

1. You must have a Mall of America® issued wristband in order to enter the autograph line. A limited number of wristbands will be available in the Rotunda beginning at Noon on Thursday, November 14. **Wristbands will be distributed on a first come, first served basis.**
2. The time at which you line up is at your discretion. There will be a holding line near the Rotunda if arriving prior to Noon on November 14.
3. In order to get a Mall of America wristband, you must purchase a copy of the book **“THE PIONEER WOMAN COOKS: THE NEW FRONTIER”** from the Barnes & Noble kiosk in the Rotunda on the day of the event. The Barnes & Noble kiosk will open at Noon on Thursday, November 14. Showing books previously purchased from other locations or online will not get you a wristband.
4. Wristbands are non-transferrable. Each person in your party must be present to receive a wristband. You may not pick up wristbands for another member of your party. People wearing wristbands that have been tampered or altered with will not be allowed through the meet and greet line. No exceptions.
5. Adults accompanying minors do not need a wristband to enter the meet and greet line.
6. Wristbanded guests may have one posed photo with Ree. This must be a single photo or a group photo; not both.
7. Personalization in the form of names will be allowed, but no additional messages.
8. Due to time limitations, no additional memorabilia can be signed.
9. Ree will sign all copies of **“THE PIONEER WOMAN COOKS: THE NEW FRONTIER”** purchased at the Barnes & Noble kiosk on the event date. Due to time restriction, Ree will only be able to sign (1) additional backlist book purchased.
10. When you enter the line, please remain single file. You must stay in line to keep your place. You may leave the line to use the restroom or get food for a short period of time. One person in your party must stay in line at all times.
11. If you choose to leave for an extended period of time, you must go to the end of the line when you return.
12. No chairs, blankets, pillows, strollers, etc. will be allowed in the line. All bags are subject to search.
13. A special needs area will be available for wristbanded guests. If needed, each special needs guest can bring one additional person to this area. Please visit the Mall of America entry table located in the Rotunda upon your arrival, and you will be escorted into this area. Space will be limited and will be filled on a first come, first served basis.

Guidelines are subject to change at any given time at the discretion of Mall of America Management for the safety and well-being of our guests and tenants. Those who do not comply with event guidelines may not be able to participate in the event.
